The file can be reactivated by notification, in writing, to the Board, of a renewed interest in becoming licensed. **Applicants whose files become inactive will no longer receive correspondence from the Board until the file is reactivated.** If your application has been on file for some time please check with this office to be sure it is complete and current.

The next exam is scheduled for October 1, 2010.

Cancellation Policy:

- There will be a \$25 administration cost per exam part, for cancellation up to 30 calendar days prior to examination date.
- Examination fees will be forfeited when canceling within 30 calendar days of examination except as noted below.
- Examination fees, less a \$25 administration cost, **per part** of the exam, can be carried over to the next exam sitting (one time only) per the applicant's request before a deadline of 30 days prior to a pending examination. No refunds will be made.
- Refunds for examination fees, less a \$25 administration cost **per part** of the exam (FG and PG), will be made upon applicant's furnishing satisfactory proof of extenuating circumstances within the 30 day period prior to a pending exam.
- Application fees will not be refunded

Applications to be considered must contain the following:

1. **Signed and notarized application form and \$55 nonrefundable application fee.**
2. **Candidates for Part 1, Fundamentals of Geology will be qualified solely on the basis of meeting the necessary educational requirements (30 semester hours of undergraduate or graduate level courses).**
 - Examination fee - due with the exam order form.
 - Original Copy of Transcripts
3. **Candidates for Part 2 Principals & Practice of Geology**
 - Examination fee - due with the exam order form.
 - (5) Professional reference forms. It is your responsibility to check with your references to verify that they have mailed them to us in time to meet the deadline. At least three references must be licensed geologists or engineers.
 - Equivalent of (5) years education and experience:
 - Undergraduate degree in Geology and (3) years experience
 - Graduate degree in Geology and (1) year experience.
 - Original copy of Transcripts.
 - Verification of experience.

Incomplete Applications

- Applications which are not completed within one (1) calendar year of the initial date will be returned to the applicant, marked as "Incomplete". Prepaid examination fees will be refunded at that time, less a \$25 administration cost **per part**, and contents of the file on hand (references, etc.), will be placed on inactive status. No further contact by the Board will be made with the applicant, unless the applicant initiates a move to reactivate the file. Application fees will not be refunded.
